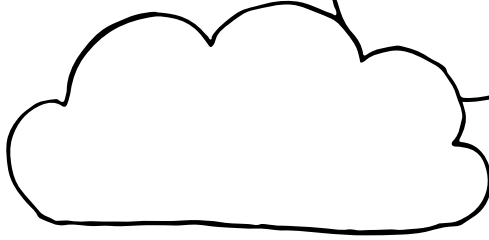
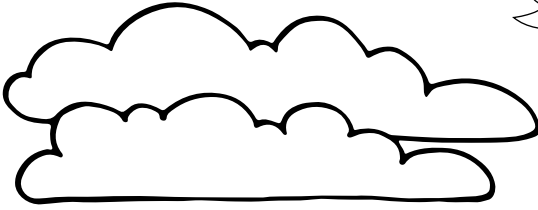
**FUN FACT**

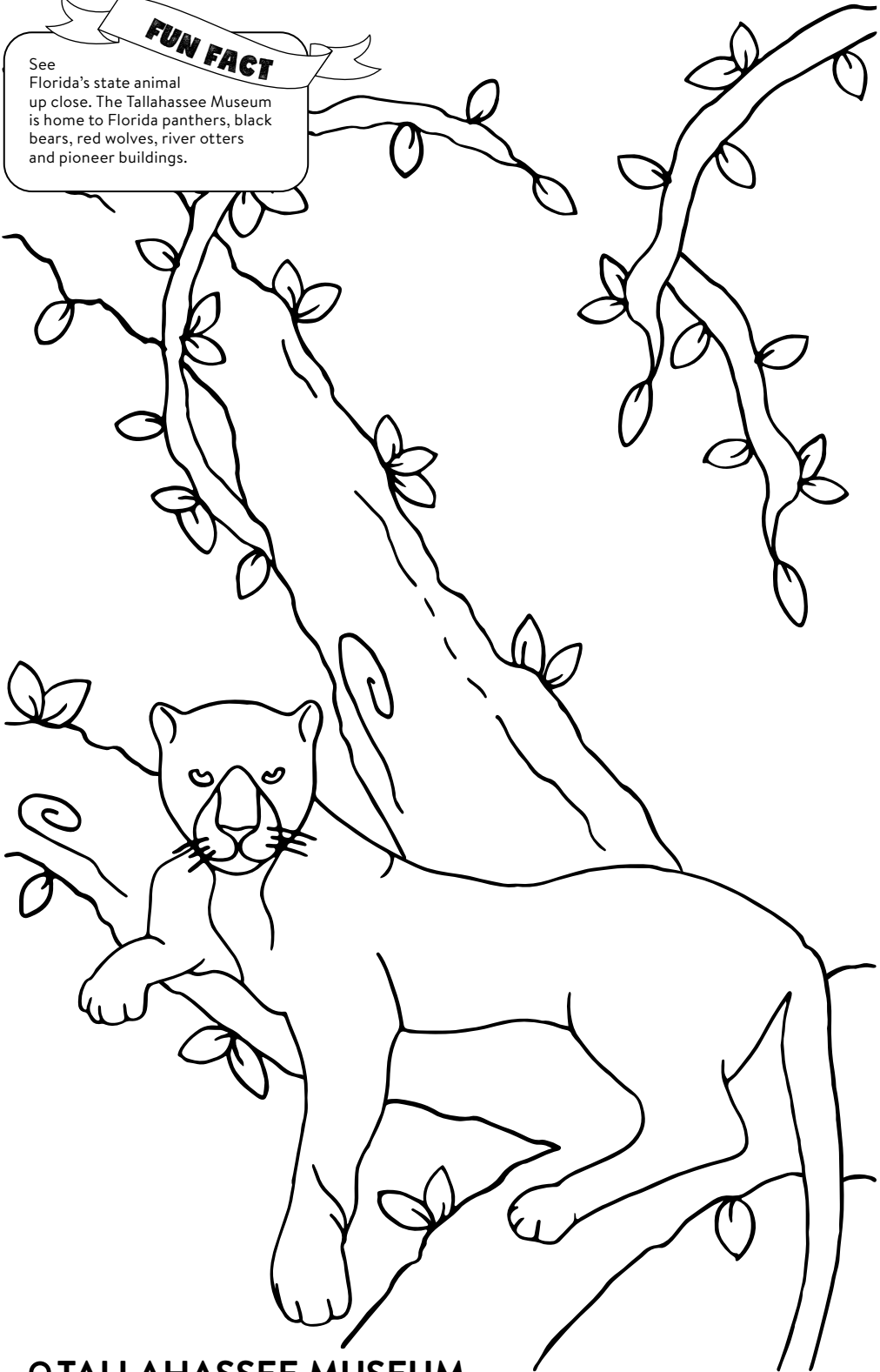

Explore the trails, marvel at historic monuments, see live concerts at the outdoor amphitheater, or enjoy the interactive play areas.



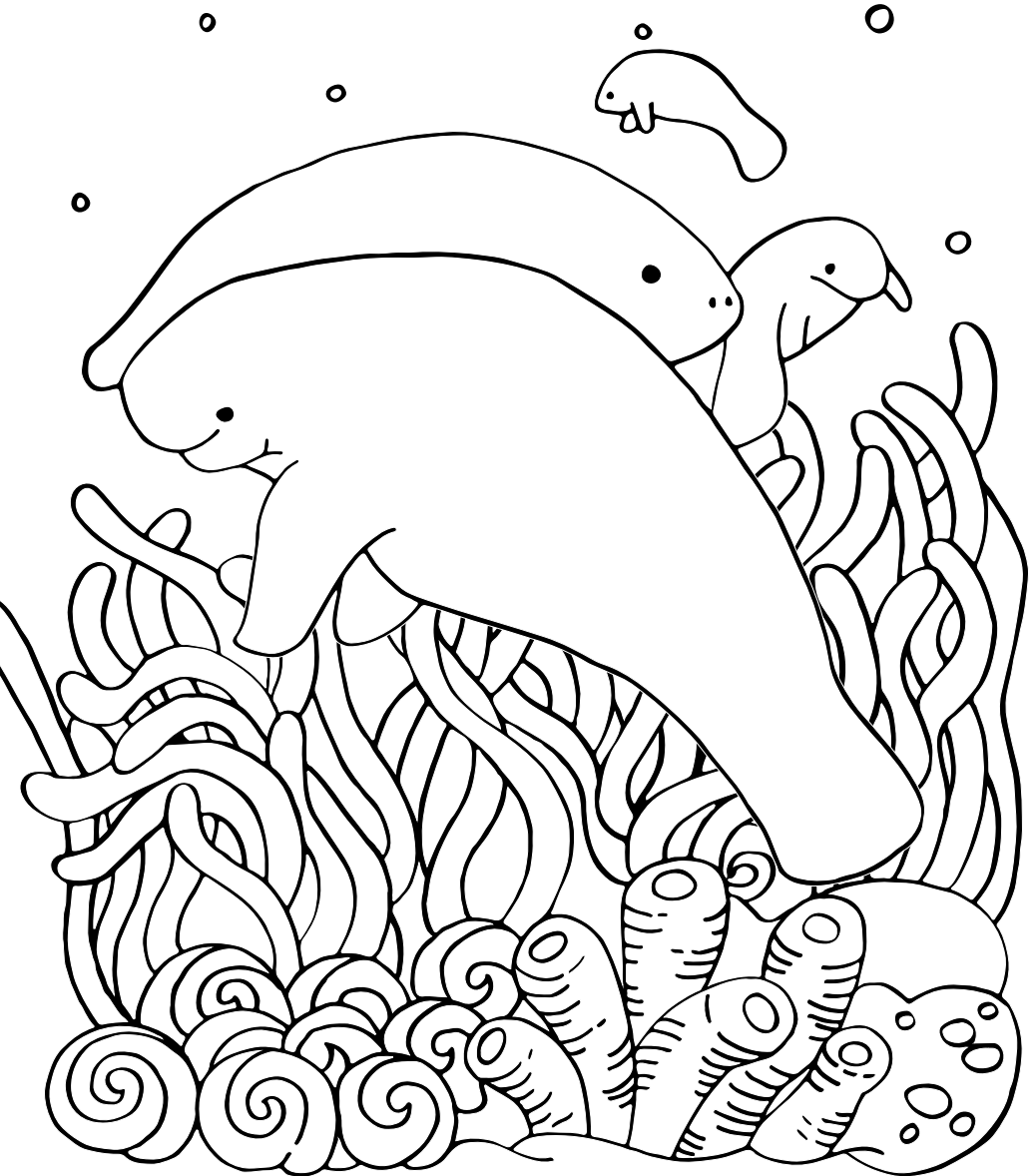
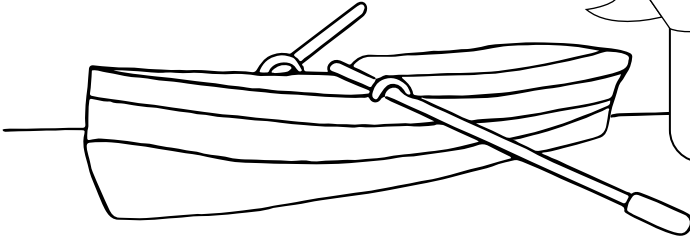

See Florida's state animal up close. The Tallahassee Museum is home to Florida panthers, black bears, red wolves, river otters and pioneer buildings.



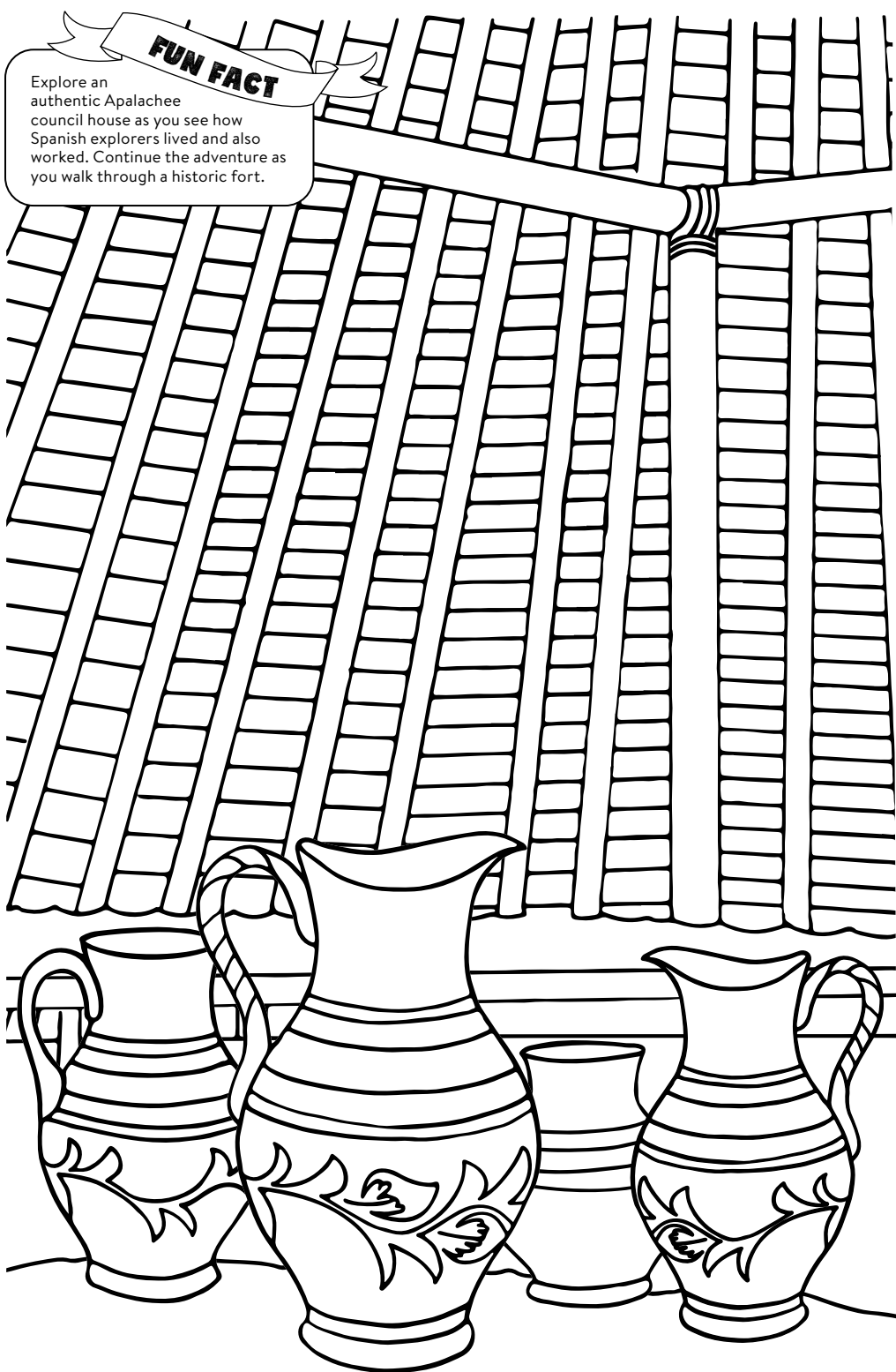
**FUN FACT**

Home to one the largest and deepest freshwater springs in the world, this park plays host to an abundance of wildlife including alligators, turtles, manatees, deer, and birds.



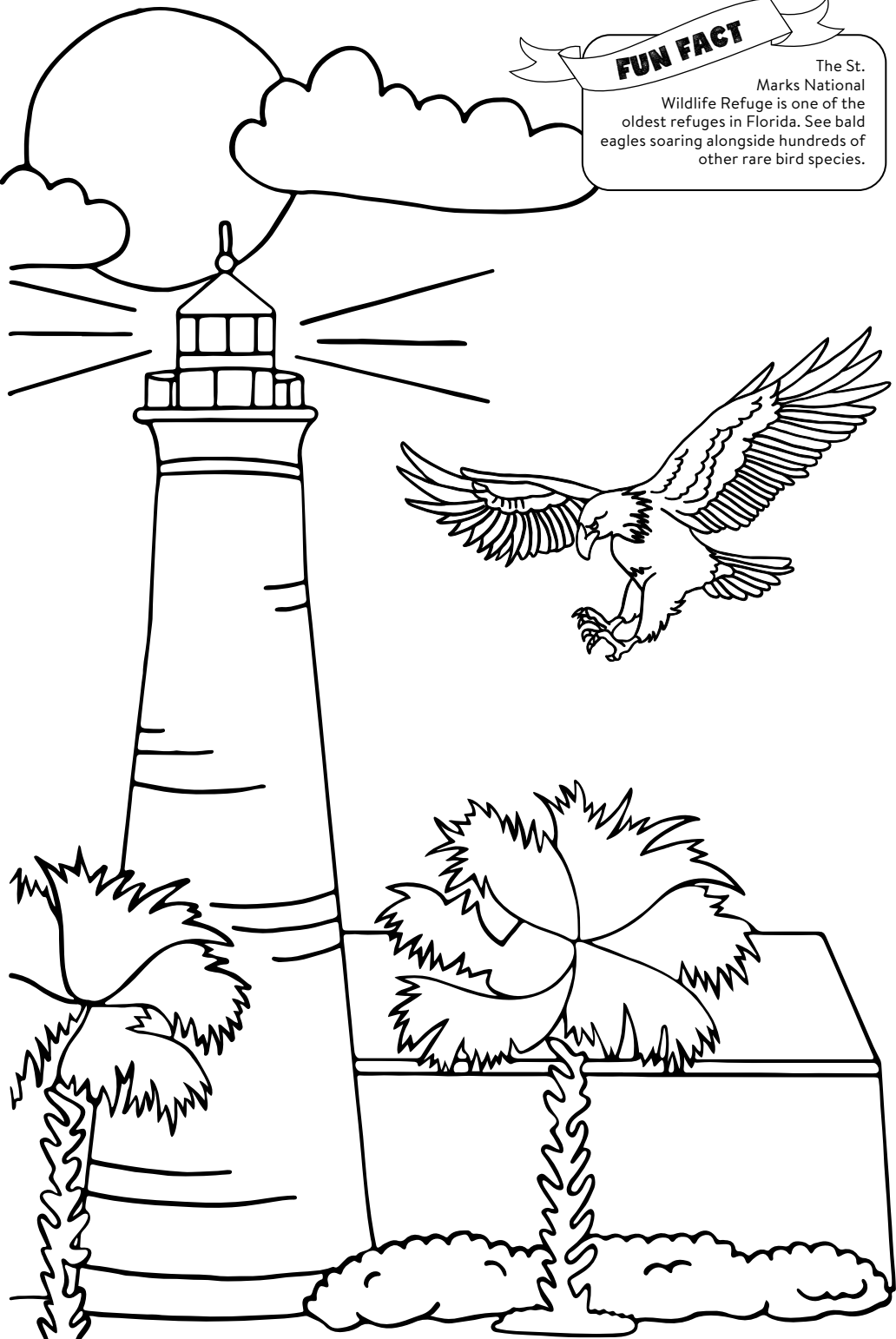
## FUN FACT

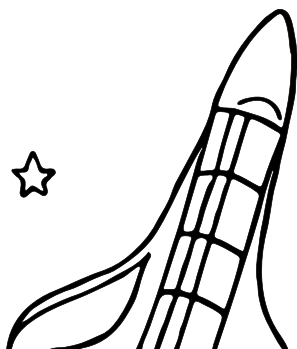
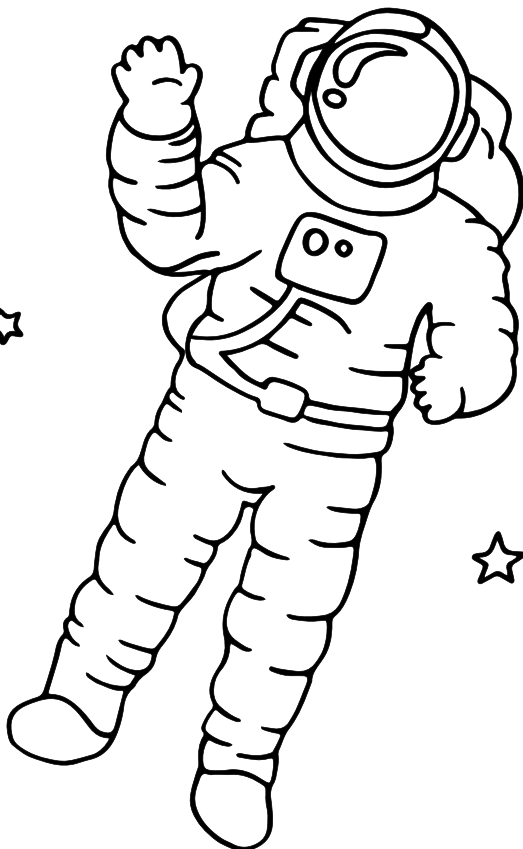
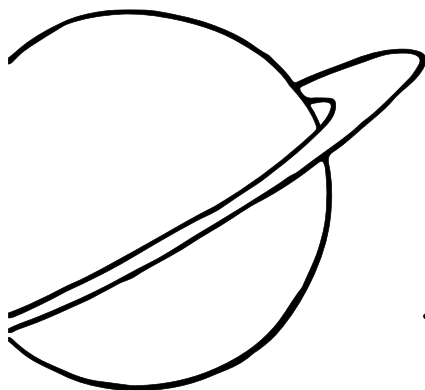
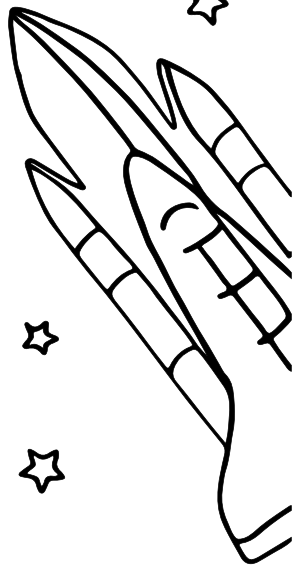
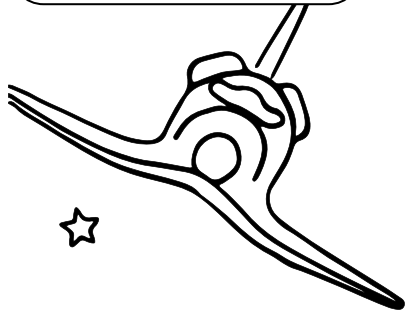
The St. Marks National Wildlife Refuge is one of the oldest refuges in Florida. See bald eagles soaring alongside hundreds of other rare bird species.

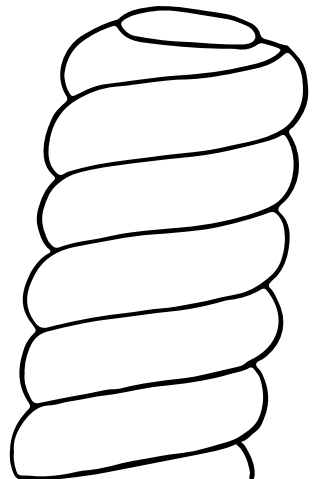
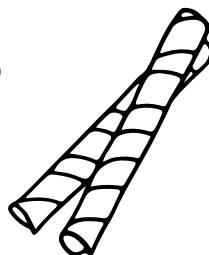
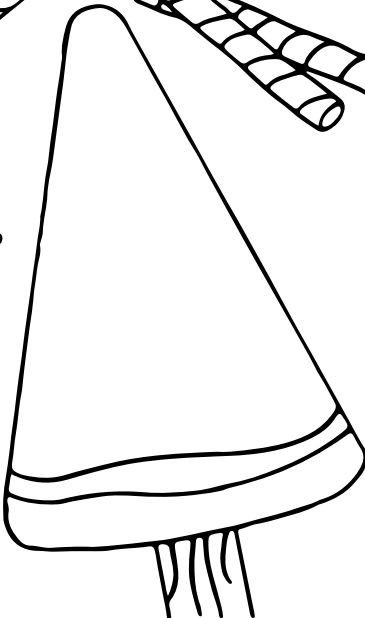
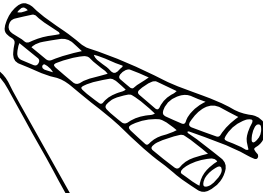
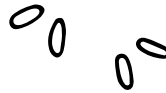
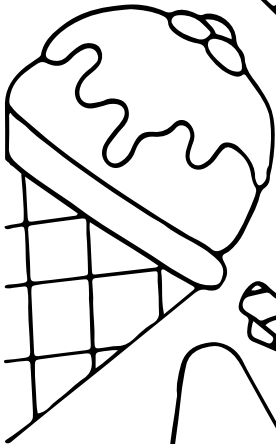
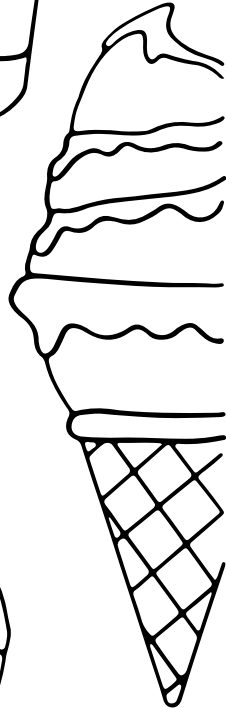
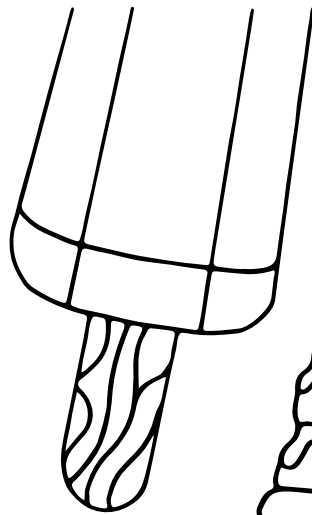
The Capitol grounds are blooming with history. The holly tree on property is one that George Washington planted at Mount Vernon!

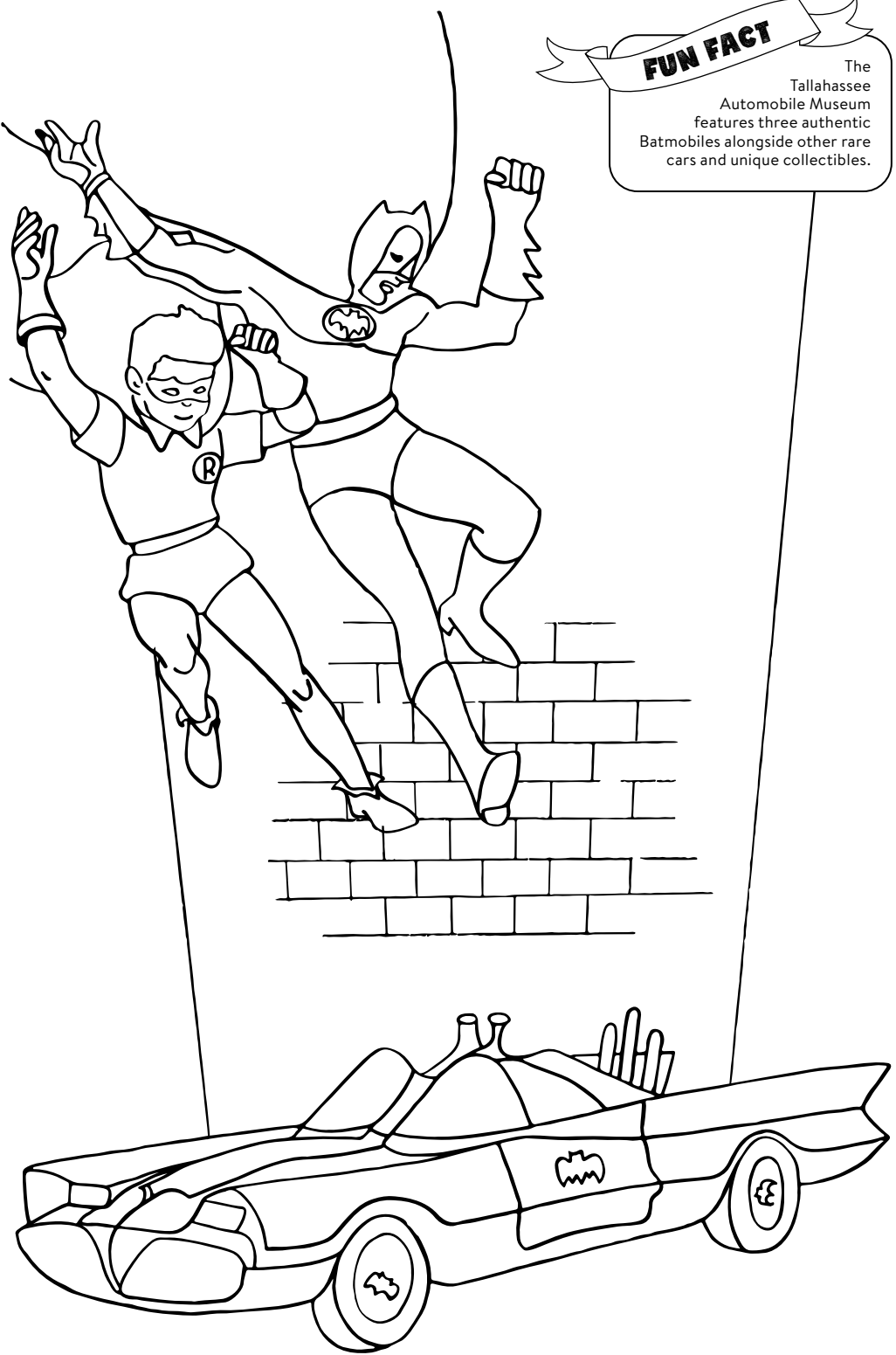
