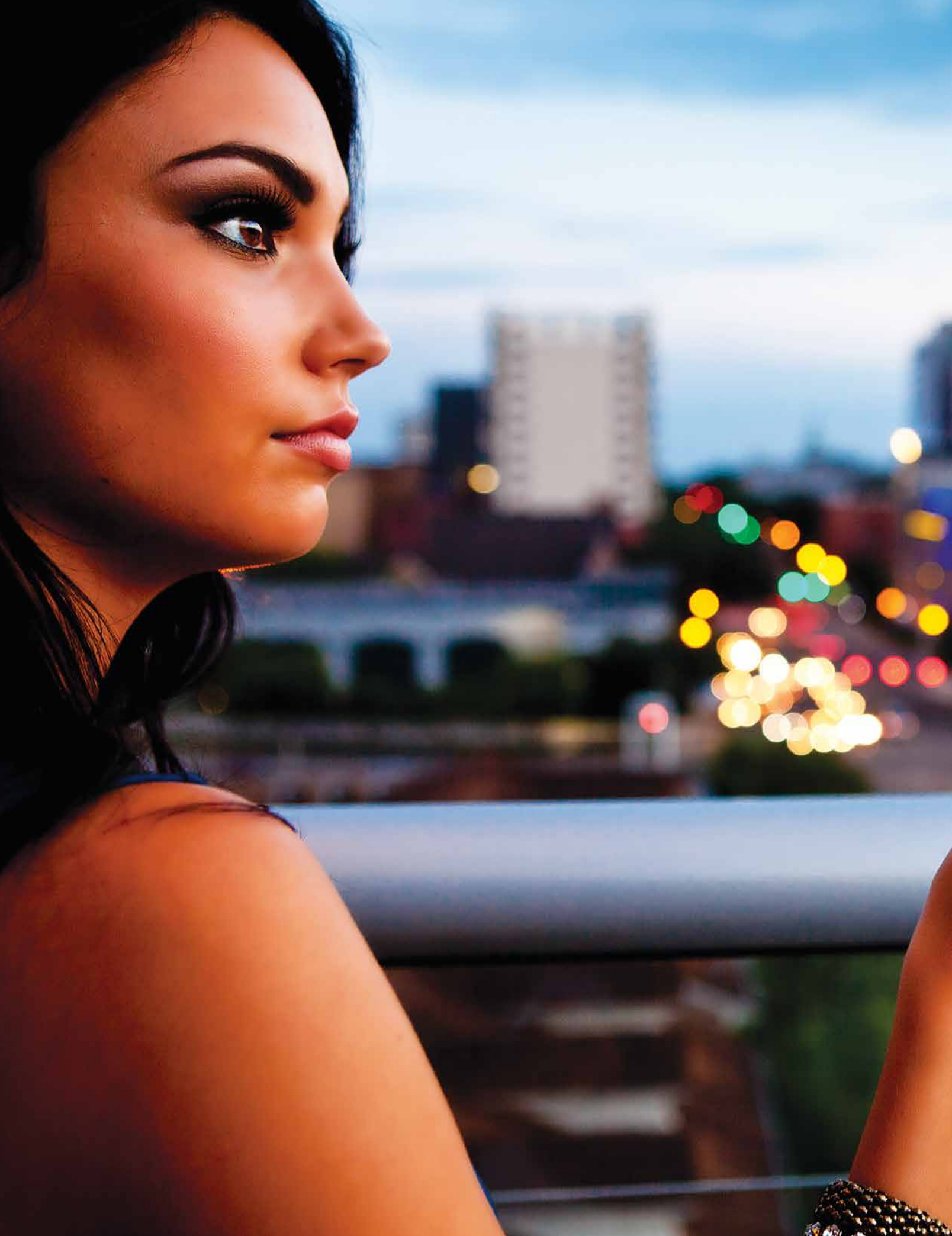

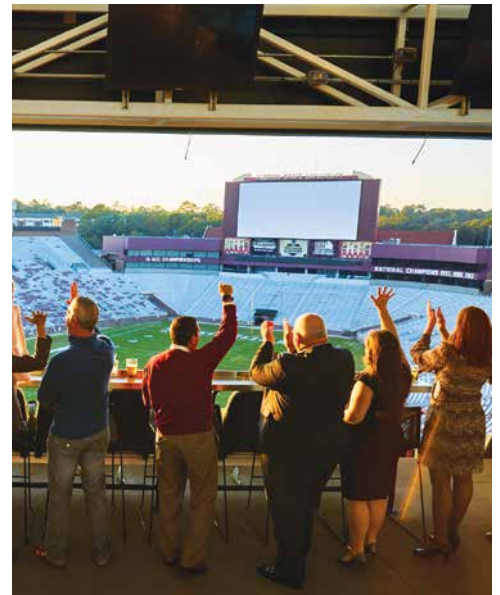

# GREEN MEETINGS

Incorporating green initiatives into your next meeting or event has never been easier. Below is a list of 10 Tips to get you started and additional resources.



**REDUCE PAPER** Send electronic copies of agendas and/or presentations before the meeting. When printing is necessary, be sure to print double-sided and provide receptacles for recycling the paper afterward.

**USE REUSABLE (OR RECYCLABLE) NAMETAGS/BADGE HOLDERS** Do this so name tags can be used at future events.

**REUSE SUPPLIES** Before buying new supplies, check your organization's inventory. Consider "greener" options for the new items you need.

**GREEN VENDING** Ask your caterer/vendors to avoid using single-use items, such as Styrofoam, plastic, straws and disposable plates and utensils. If that's not possible, paper and cardboard products are better disposable options than plastic and Styrofoam.

**CHOOSE A "GREEN" VENUE** Select hotels and venues offering green policies and practices or actively work with the selected venue to ensure green practices are being implemented.

**BUY LOCAL** When ordering food for your meeting, order from local suppliers and avoid waste by double-checking your numbers. Donate leftovers to a local food bank or homeless shelter.

**SKIP THE BOTTLED WATER** Save money and the planet by serving water and other drinks in pitchers and/or coolers with reusable cups/glassware.

**TAKE A BREAK** When planning the agenda, be sure to include breaks for stretching and walking. Healthy practices are sustainable too.

**CONSERVE ENERGY** When the meeting concludes, turn off all lights and electronics.

**BRAG ABOUT YOUR EFFORTS** Make sure attendees are aware of the green initiatives implemented into the meeting and ask for their help in recycling and energy conservation during the event. Every little bit helps.
