ATTRACTIONS

Tallahassee Museum – With 52 acres of natural wonders, historic buildings, high-flying adventures, and animal exhibits, this is no typical museum.

Soul Voices of Frenchtown – The Frenchtown neighborhood is a living and breathing monument to the contributions of the African American community in Tallahassee. The story of Frenchtown continues to be told, and the voices of its residents bring that story to life.

Tallahassee Automobile Museum – Features more than 130 rare autos including an 1894 Duryea, 1931 Duesenberg, the Tucker and Batmobiles. Other collections include antique boat motors, Native American artifacts, sports memorabilia, motorcycles, and pedal cars.

Art Murals Tour – This self-guided tour offers an opportunity to experience and appreciate Tallahassee's spectacular murals.

Bradley's Country Store - This family-owned store, listed on the National Register of Historic Places, is famous for its homemade sausage and country milled grits, both of which are still made on-site.
